



Uniform Manifest for Interstate (Importation) Movements of Motor Fuel and Diesel Motor Fuel

FT-960

This manifest must be completed by the transporter and carried for all movements of motor fuel or diesel motor fuel into or through New York State (NYS) that originate from a point outside NYS. For all movements of motor fuel and diesel motor fuel that originate from a point within NYS, complete Form FT-970, *Uniform Manifest for Intrastate Movements of Motor Fuel and Diesel Motor Fuel*. The manifest must be produced for inspection upon the request of a police officer or a representative of the Tax Department, and must be identifiable by the assignment of a manifest number by the transporter.

Failure to carry a manifest or carrying one that is not complete in every material respect is a crime and may result in the seizure or forfeiture of both the vessel or vehicle transporting the fuel and its contents.

It is a **felony** to willfully prepare a manifest that is known to be not correct in every material respect, or to produce for inspection a manifest known to be false in any material matter.
