



**Notice to Individuals Making Personal Income Tax
Payments by Credit Card**

Beginning June 16, 2015, individuals will not be able to use a credit card to pay a balance due when filing a 2014 personal income tax return or to make an estimated tax payment.

Taxpayers may continue to use credit cards to pay a bill or notice.

The Tax Department anticipates that individuals will be able to resume using credit cards to pay a balance due on personal income tax returns or make estimated tax payments through an [Online Services](#) account starting in January 2016.

Other payment options

Individuals may pay a balance due on a personal income tax return or make an estimated tax payment by paying directly from a bank account or mailing a check or money order.

Note: An N-Notice is generally issued to announce a singular event, such as an update to a previously issued tax form or instruction, or to announce a new due date for filing returns and making payments of tax because of a natural disaster. The department does not revise previously issued N-Notices.
