General Information

1985 was the last year that taxpayers filing on a calendar-year basis could claim the solar and wind credit. However, this credit can be carried over from year to year until it is used up. The credit can be applied against the New York State personal income tax and the additional tax on unearned income after first deducting the following credits:

Resident tax credit
Accumulation distribution credit
Child and dependent care credit
Household credit
Economic Development Zone (EDZ) capital corporation tax credit
Economic Development Zone (EDZ) wage tax credit
Investment credit
Special additional mortgage recording tax credit

This credit cannot be applied against the minimum income tax, the separate tax on higher education (PASS) funds and the separate tax on lump sum distributions.
