Exempt sales and uses

Table for Exempt sales and uses with columns for line number and Gallons. Rows 9-19 include various exemptions like sales to registered businesses and residential heating.

Table for Taxable gallons with columns for A Gallons, Petroleum business tax rate, and B Tax. Row 20 shows taxable gallons to be accounted for.

Taxable sales and uses

Table for Taxable sales and uses with columns for line number, A Gallons, Petroleum business tax rate, and B Tax. Rows 21-25 include nonresidential heating, rate-regulated electric corporations, and other taxable sales.

Adjustments

Table for Adjustments with columns for line number, A Gallons, Petroleum business tax rate, and B Tax. Row 26 shows adjustments to tax.

Balance due/credit

Table for Balance due/credit with columns for line number, A Gallons, Petroleum business tax rate, and B Tax. Row 27 shows total tax/credit due.

Transfer the amount on line 27 to Form PT-100, Petroleum Business Tax Return, line 3.

Rate-per-gallon explanation chart. .038 - includes the rate for the petroleum business tax at the nonresidential heating rate only. .071 - includes the rate for the petroleum business tax at the commercial gallonage rate only. .139 - includes the full rate for the petroleum business tax only.
