Instructions

Purpose of Form TP-584-SNY

Use Form TP-584-SNY to claim exemption from the real estate transfer tax related to leases of real property located in tax-free NY areas to an approved business participating in the START-UP NY program.

Note: You must file Form TP-584 for all other conveyances of real property located in New York.

When and where to file

File Form TP-584-SNY with the recording officer of the county where the real property being conveyed is located, **no later** than the fifteenth day after the delivery of the instrument effecting the conveyance. However, if the instrument effecting the conveyance will not be recorded, file Form TP-584-SNY **no** later than the fifteenth day after the delivery of the instrument effecting the conveyance, directly with:

Private delivery services - If you choose, you may use a private delivery service, instead of the U.S. Postal Service, to mail in your form and tax payment. However, if, at a later date, you need to establish the date you filed or paid your tax, you cannot use the date recorded by a private delivery service unless you used a delivery service that has been designated by the U.S. Secretary of the Treasury or the Commissioner of Taxation and Finance. (Currently designated delivery services are listed in Publication 55, Designated Private Delivery Services. See Need help? for information on obtaining forms and publications.) If you have used a designated private delivery service and need to establish the date you filed your form, contact that private delivery service for instructions on how to obtain written proof of the date your form was given to the delivery service for delivery. If you use any private delivery service, whether it is a designated service or not, send the forms covered by these instructions to: NYS Tax Department, Misc Tax/RETT Unit, W A Harriman Campus, Albany NY 12227.

Information relating to conveyance

Name and address box

Print or type the names, addresses, and social security or employer identification numbers of the grantor and grantee. If the grantor or grantee is a single member LLC, enter the names and identification numbers (SSN and/or EIN) for both the LLC and the single member. If additional space is needed, please attach a schedule to Form TP-584-SNY setting forth the names, addresses, and social security or employer identification numbers of all the grantors and grantees.

Location and description of property conveyed

Give the location and description of the interest in real property being leased including the tax map designation and address. Also include the name of the city or village, town, and county where the property being leased is located.

Condition of conveyance

Indicate by marking an X in the appropriate box whether the property conveyed is a leasehold grant or leasehold assignment. If the conveyance is a leasehold grant, indicate the maximum term of the lease (by number of years), including all options to renew.

Date of conveyance

The exemption applies to leases conveyed on or after January 1, 2014.

For leasehold grants, enter the date the lease commences as stated in the leasehold agreement.

For leasehold assignments, enter the effective date of the assignment as stated in the assignment agreement.

Signatures

Both the grantor(s) and the grantee(s) must sign Form TP-584-SNY. If there is not adequate space for all persons to sign, a separate signature sheet may be used and attached to Form TP-584-SNY.
