The current expectation is that DTF will continue to maintain an image in its current Electronic Data Management System. Any interfaces for COTS would be discussed at a later point.

The CARTS system was developed in-house and includes a backend COBOL batch running on zOS mainframe with IDMS the primary database and limited IBM DB2. Front includes some CICS green screens with a large percentage converted to Java web application and interacting with Cobol modules thru CICS transaction Gateway.
