Qualified Empire Zone Enterprise (QEZE) Sales and Use Tax Refund Rates

Effective March 1, 2022

Part 1 – Businesses certified by Empire State Development (ESD) before April 1, 2009

Businesses certified by ESD before April 1, 2009, may apply for a refund of the New York State and MCTD (if applicable) sales and use tax, and in some cases, local sales and use tax, on qualifying purchases. You may apply for a refund **only** if you have applied for and received Form DTF-81, *Qualified Empire Zone Enterprise Sales Tax Certification*, from the Tax Department. You must also receive your *Empire Zone Retention Certificate* from ESD before applying for a refund, and meet all of the other eligibility requirements. A refund claim may be filed only once each sales tax quarter.

Part 2 - Businesses certified by (ESD) on or after April 1, 2009

A business certified by ESD on or after April 1, 2009, may apply for a refund or credit of New York State and, if applicable, MCTD sales and use tax on qualifying purchases **only** if the locality where the purchase is made elects to provide this refund. If a locality is not listed below, it has not enacted this refund and **no** refund of any New York State, MCTD, or local tax is allowed.

You must receive your *Empire Zone Retention Certificate* from ESD before applying for a refund. A refund claim may be filed only once each sales tax quarter.
